End 68 Hours of Hunger is excited and honored to have been chosen to participate in this quarters GIVE-A-CLICK campaign. End 68 Hours of Hunger is a nationwide program with each individual chapter being responsible for their own donations (monetary and/or food) . The Dracut chapter was the 1st one established in Massachusetts and is currently serving 35 children weekly.

End 68 provides backpacks of non perishable foods to each of the Dracut public schools and the administrative staff hands those backpacks out each Friday to our children in need to ensure they will have food for over the weekends when they do not have access to the free breakfasts and lunches served at school.

Over the summer End 68 provides boxes of non perishable foods to each family to help them make their food budget last a bit longer when their kids are home all day. If End 68 wins this competition and is awarded the \$1500.00 prize that money would help keep our back packs full as this fall we are expanding our reach to include all grades at the Innovations Charter academy in Tyngsboro. This school includes children from 11 Merrimack Valley cities and towns and we are expecting the number of back packs filled to at least double once the program is in place at Innovations.

End 68 Hours is a nonprofit organization and all funds donated go directly to purchasing food for the backpacks. All of the people involved with this program are volunteers and donate their time.
