Place of Promise is a faith-based organization founded 26 years ago to serve men, women, and children whose lives have been broken by addictions. We come alongside them and help rebuild their lives.

The core of our ministry is an Adult Long-Term Residential Program. We operate 4 long-term residential homes that provide a safe living community where men and women can heal physically, emotionally, relationally, and spiritually. We provide clinical support for medical and mental care as well as instruction in life skills such as repentance, confession, receiving forgiveness, setting healthy boundaries, and relapse prevention.

Individuals come to Place of Promise with a long history of homelessness, incarceration, neglected medical conditions, mental disorders, abuse, trauma, and alcohol and opioid drug addictions. Our only criterion for entry is a genuine desire for a new life.

At Place of Promise, a life can be transformed, leaving behind death and despair while beginning a new life of hope and potential.

Place of Promise is located in Lowell and primarily serves those in Lowell and the Boston metropolitan area. In the last year, we served over 100 men and women. Place of Promise serves those that have no financial resources – they have nothing and have nowhere to go, but desire a new life. Your donation will be used to help these men and women prepare themselves to lead new lives as they return to their families and communities.
